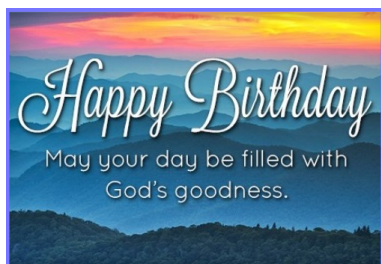

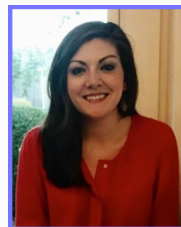

Our next meeting will be Thursday, May 11th. We would love to have you join our group and benefit from the love, friendship, and fun we have to offer.

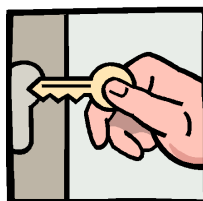
